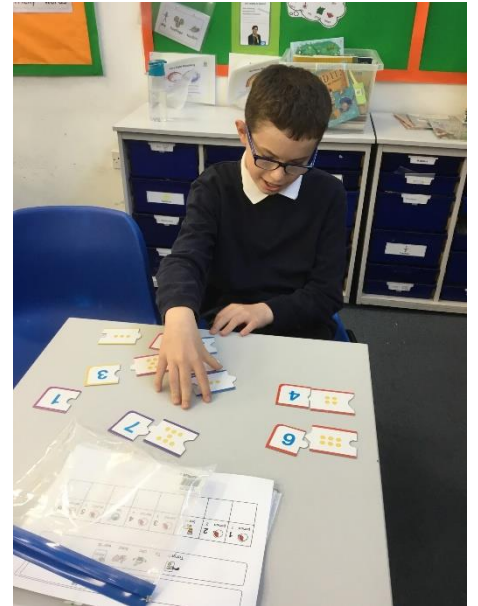


Orange Class
