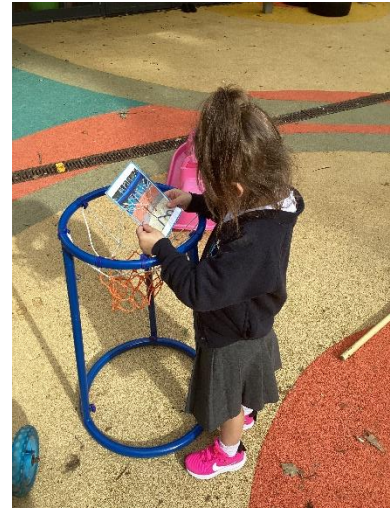
In science we have been exploring our senses: for touch we had lots of different textures to explore. We had things that were cold, warm, spiky, rough, smooth and soft.
