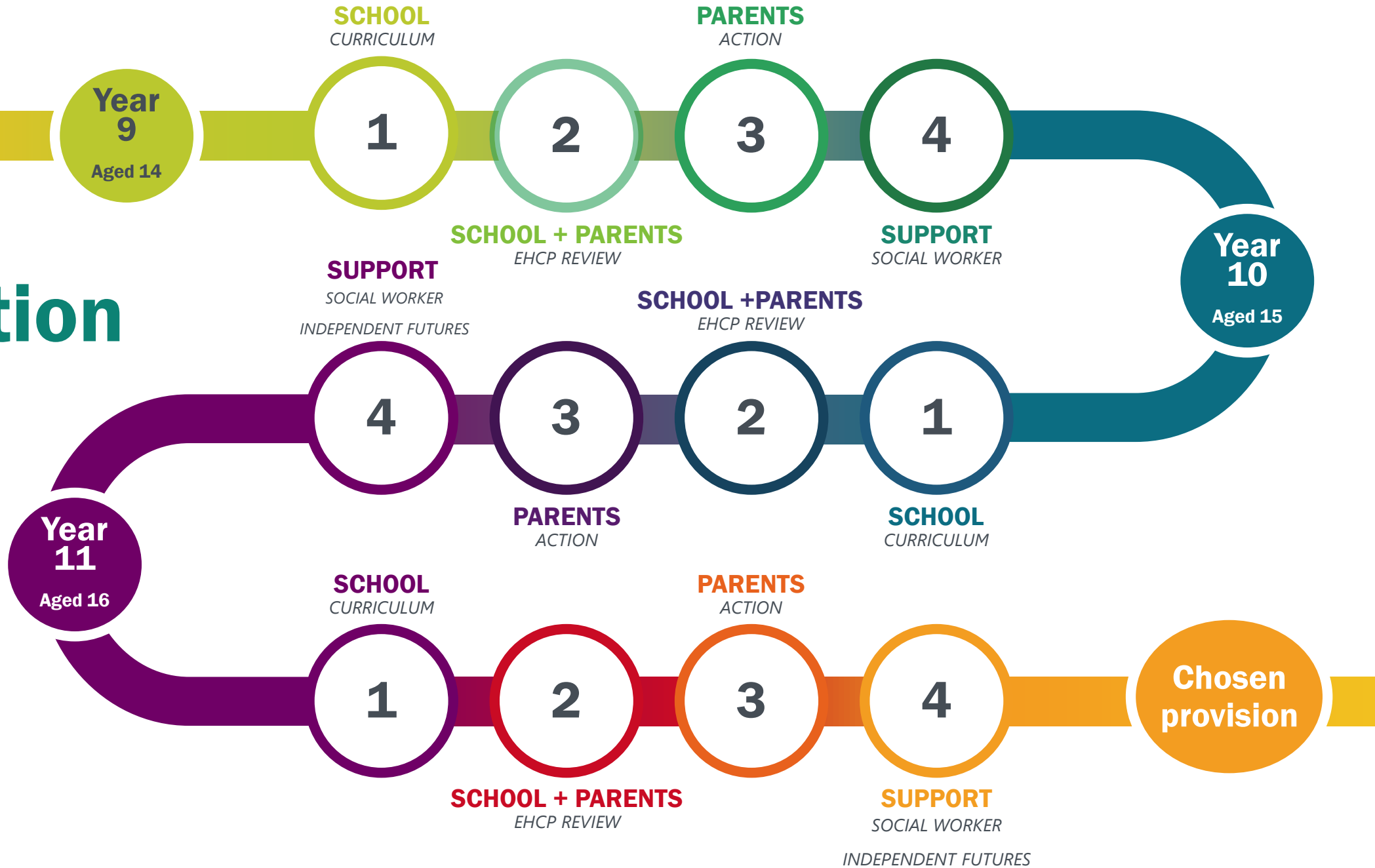

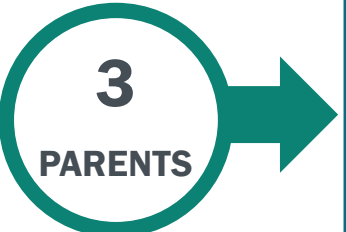
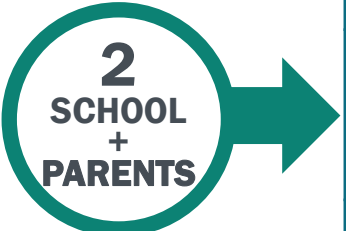

After discussions with your child and school:

Attend open evening at your local college

Attend other colleges open evenings that offer the course your child is interested in

Visiting:

Take your child's EHCP plan with you

Take the Hampshire 'visiting colleges' guidance with you

Ask to speak to the Foundation Learning Department

Go to as many open evenings as you can

Applying:

Apply early in the Autumn Term of Year 11

Apply to more than 1 college

Apply for a course that is at your child's working level (ask the school if you not sure)

You can apply online

Interview and transition:

Colleges will ask for an interview

Colleges will confirm a place

Colleges should provide a transition session(s)

Inform school of where you are in the process, we can support you
